**AGE GROUP FOR CREATING:** 8-10 years

TIME OF PREPARATION: 30 minutes

## PROCEDURE(HOW THE TOY CAN BE USED):

1. Make your letter board ready.

2.Keep the circle cutouts on

which sounds are written in a bowl.

3. Shuffle the circle cutouts.

4. Take out anyone cut out, read the

sound and place it on the correct letter on the board.
